

- ❖ Sarvangasana or Shoulder Stand Pose.




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
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

We with staff all the students participated in swachh bharat of our HKES POLYTECHNIC COLLEGE campus






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

- Average time for each activity would be limited to 30 minutes.



### Report on “Awareness on Student scholarship”


A scholarship is a form of financial aid awarded to students for further education. Generally, scholarships are awarded based on a set of criteria such as academic merit.
